CAPITULATION IN SINAI. (contd.)

Meanwhile --- at Algiers --- the French warship Jean Bart was taking aboard men and supplies for the Eastern Mediterranean. They included infantry of the famous H Battalion and parachute troops.

Tanks and heavy equipment accompanied them on the freighter Oradour.

Then following the destruction of the Egyptian Air Force by the Anglo-French Air Forces and naval warplanes, preparations were made for the dropping of airborne troops.

In a matter of a few hours, with the assistance of other troops disembarked in the harbours, negotiations began for the surrender of Port Said. Mad Quickly on the heels of action followed the decision of the British Government.
