New York: Seventy nine countries were represented at the United Nations General Assembly - a world tribunal sitting in judgment on a Member State.

In this unhappy chapter, no praise is too high for the conduct of the Austrian border-police. On this occasion, (hearing that ~~the~~ refugees intended swimming the swiftly-flowing river), they ferried them across in rubber boats.

There is no doubt that many ~~of~~ children owe their lives to the <sup>courage</sup> ~~courageous actions~~ of the border-police - despite the <sup>menace</sup> ~~threat~~ of ruthless Soviet troops.
