America -- Sweeping down to the coast from the Santa Ménica mountains, a raging brush fire in three days blackened over 12,000 acres of tinder-fry undergrowth, besides destroying numerous dwellings.

Firefighters fought desponded to prevent the flames from spreading to the homes of many Hollywood film stars. In spite of their heroic efforts, over 100 houses were gutted, with fortunately only one loss of life.

Later- not two miles away, a second outbreak (believed to have been deliberately started) enveloped Mattha the township of Malibu, causing a speedy evacuation of the inhabitants. And a state of emergency was declared throughout S.W. California.
