War Memorial-

The Far East -- At the Kranji Military Cemetery, Sir Robert Black-Governor of Singapore- unveiled a giant granite memorial to 24,000 men and women of different races and creeds, who died in the South Eqs Asia campaigns, and have ho known grave.

Berlin_. The Reichstag (Germany's Parliament) which was burnt down nearly 24 years ago, is now to be rebuilt.

America -- Following a night collision in the Delaware River, New Jersey, a U.S. Navy tanker "Mission San Francisco" became a flaming wreck, after being cut in two half by the Liberian cargo ship "Elna II". Daylight showed the furious blaze was still unchecked, and the doomed vessel was eventually sank.

The crew of the Elna II and 35 members of the tanker's crew were rescued, but nine of the ill-fated "Mission of San Francisco" are missing- including her commander.
