

War Memorial-

The Far East-- At the Kranji Military Cemetery, Sir Robert Black-Governor of Singapore- unveiled a giant granite memorial to 24,000 men and women of different races and creeds, who died in the ~~the~~ South East Asia campaigns, and have no known grave.

The memorial is of carved Portland stone in the form of a sheltering aircraft wing, supported by twelve wide columns.

Many relatives and friends came to pay personal tribute to a ~~not-forgotten~~ not-forgotten company of heroes.

Reichstag-

Berlin-- The Reichstag (Germany's Parliament) which was burnt down nearly 24 years ago, is now to be rebuilt.

The Bonn Treasury has announced a grant of £300,000 over the next fourteen months, for reconstruction purposes, in the hope that one day Berlin will again be the capital of ~~the~~ <sup>a</sup> united Germany.

Ship Collision-

America-- Following a night collision in the Delaware River, New Jersey, a U.S. Navy tanker "Mission San Francisco" became a flaming wreck, after being cut in ~~two~~ half by the Liberian cargo ship "Elna II". Daylight showed the furious blaze was still unchecked, and the doomed vessel ~~was~~ eventually sank.

The crew of the Elna II and 35 members of the tanker's crew were rescued, but nine of the ill-fated "Mission of San Francisco" are missing- including her ~~captain~~ Commander.
