On a modern bilgrimage of goodwill - a graceful reminder of a common heritage, the Mayflower II approached Plymouth Rock, Massachussetts - in after a fifty-four day Atlantic crossing from Plymouth, Devon...

It was in a similar fessel that the "Pilgrim Fathers" braved the unknown to settle in America - their historic landing is commemorated by Plymouth Rock

At that time, there was already a flourishing colony at Jamestown,

Virginia. And the British carrier, H.M.S. Ark Royal joined warships of seventeen other Nations in a great Naval Review - marking the 350th anniversaryof the foundation of this permanent English settlement.

Meanwhile, the Mayflower Festival was in full swing.
