Fifty years ago, Robert Baden-Powell became the "pathfinder" - leading a few boys towards a new brotherhood for the youth of the world.

To-day, a great trek pays tribute to his vision and ideals - as 34,000 Scouts, representing ^{More than 80} ~~eighty~~ countries, gather for their Jubilee Jamboree - at Sutton Coldfield.

At the entrance of the huge camp, National emblems trace the growth of the Scout Movement - from Holland to Hong Kong - from Britain to far-off Borneo...

Inside, a "city of tents" is the common ground between Scouts of every race and creed. Here, for twelve days, this world fellow-ship of youth will share the daily routine - from cleaning and polishing the camp to the ~~daily~~ preparation of ~~meals~~ food ^{for more than} - ~~two~~ two million meals ~~to~~ be served...

This was the ideal of the great B.P. that a jamboree should be the ~~meeting place for the boys of the world to find greater understanding~~ ^{from every part of the world} meeting place for boys - from New Zealand, from Holland, from the whole world, to find greater understanding.

Before opening the Jamboree, the Duke of Gloucester was taken by the Chief Scout, Lord Rowallan, on a camp tour... (2)

And one stop was made at the Post Office - - a favourite souvenir spot for those special Jubilee Stamps - now being issued throughout

the country.

The Scout Jamboree is but one of four world gatherings celebrating the Centenary of the Birth of Baden-Powell. In Windsor Great Park, Guides
