Air Disaster-

August 16th. '57.

Denmark: Flags flying at half-mast were tragic pointers to a terrible disaster in Copenhagen harbour, where the wreck of a Soviet Air Liner lay, partly submerged, after crashing in thick fog. The plane, after a flight from Moscow, was coming in to make an instrument-landing at Kastrup Airport, when tragedy crossed its path. At a height of only ~~2000 feet~~ two hundred feet - the airliner hit a factory chimney near the harbour - and then made its fatal nose-dive into the ~~XXXXXX~~ water... Two young Britons, ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ (returning from the Moscow Youth Festival) were among the eighteen passengers who, with ~~XX~~ a crew of five - met an untimely death in Copenhagen Harbour...
