The Sity of San Juan suffers one of the worst earthquakes in South
American history. Populated by 85,000 people it was totally destroyed
in 40 seconds. The death roll was very heavy; over two thousand
bodies were respected and hundreds more were found daily. Respitals were
summed as ten thousand wounded called for attention. Relief was
rushed by air from CHILE and the American Red Cross. Homeless
persons were given food and help before almost whalesale evacuation began.
