- 4, V.S. Refugees returning to their homes, they greet their liberators with joy! More scenes of entry. 85
- 5, V.S. Dead civilians, executed by the German during the occupation. 27
- 6, V.S. Showing the damage done to the buildings of Kiev during the occupation, all just ruins. 42
- 7, M.S. Pile of valuable metal utensils which the Germans had collected to send back to Germany. 18
- 8, M.S. Russian soldiers remove German signs and pictures. 19
- 9, V.S. On pavement in the city Marshall Zhukov and Commissar Khrushchev greet and kiss returning refugees. 25
