The victorious diceps are H.M.S. STARLING, KITE, WILDGOOSE and MAGPIE. One other, H.M.S. WOGDPRIKER, was lest in the operation, but her entire company was safely brought back by the other ships.

Men of HoM. S. Starling come ashere in high spirits, while the German crew of the U. Boat she sank by gunfire are escorted along the Quay, lined with British sailors and Wrens.
