- 3, V.S. Flashback to film made 50 years ago starring Arthur White. Called "Life of a Fireman" it shows action a fire station, sliding down pole and rushing through the streets with horse drawn fire tender. Final shot shows him climbing out of window with child over his shoulder. 43
- 4, Flashback to Max Linder "Flypaper Slapstick" comedy where man can't get flypaper off his hands. 52
- 5, Flashback to 1902 and scenes from the Coronation of Edward VII." 5
- 6, Flashback to fashions of the Gay Nineties. 35
- 7, M.S. Early ~~hazy~~ bathing beauty parade. 30
- 8, M.S. Lillian Russell in her dressing room. 12
- 9, V.S. Tennis match of early nineties showing players in long dresses and using small racquets. 26
- 10, M.S. Last part and knock down, ^{as} of Tommy Burns ^{ko's} by Bill Squires in world heavyweight fight, one of the first ever filmed. Circa 1907. 21
- 11, M.S. Lifeguards march past Victoria Memorial during opening ceremony. 1911 11
- 12, L.S. Royalty arriving and the un^{el}rolling. 25
- 13, M.S. Old time horseless carriage being started and shakily pulling away. 16
- 14, V.S. Montage of audiences consisting of forces around the world who gather to be entertained by the stars of the silver screen. 21
