THE INVASION. Greatest Combined Operation in the World's History.

- 1, V.S. Bombers over Northern France prior to the landings. They bomb marshalling yards in softening up process. Rockets are used to bombard Normandy emplacements and fighter aircraft straff grounded aircraft and other targets. 140
- 2, Aerial shots of mass of Gliders and Dakotas with D Day markings. They wait for the off. 37
- 3, V.S. Dakotas taking off pulling gliders. 35
- 4, VS. At invasion ports the men with their battle order go aboard ships that will take them across to France. 30
- 5, V.S. Ships of all shapes and sizes, large merchant ships small landing craft. They have barrage balloons attached to them for protection as they mass in channel. 90
- 6, V.S. Off the French coast guns go into action, a barrage is laid down. We ~~few~~ from deck of ~~Fr~~ Canadian warship. 70
- 7, L.S. As the landing craft close onto the shore the German shells fall about them. 26
- 8, Aerial views of invasion fleet and of beach head being established. 45
- 9, V.S. From landing craft hitting beach and American soldiers wade waist high onto sand. 23
- 10, V.S. More British troops come ashore, the battle goes on around them. ~~Fr~~ 67
- 11, V.S. First of the wounded being brought from landing craft onto main ship of the fleet. Some stretcher cases, others just minor injuries. 26
- 12, V.S. Landing carft in British ports with the ~~the~~ wounded being carried off/helped into ambulances. 25
- 13, V.S. More of the landings with the U.S. troops going ashore with supplies. 30
- 14, L.S. Troops in ruins of French railway station. 15
- 15, V.S. More supplies including bren gun carriers. For the journey back the landing craft are loaded with German prisoners. 45
