- 1, V.S. American troops put local labour to work in repairing a Marshalling yard which received heavy bombing by the Allied ~~landing~~ air force during the occupation. 38
- 2, V.S. U.S. Troops in the bombed ruins of the town of Valagnes. 24
- 3, L.S. Buildings which ~~were~~ not quite demolished enough are finished off with the aid of dynamite. 40
- 4, V.S. At a captured German equipment dump the U.S. Troops sort through damaged tanks, cars and Guns etc. 41
- 5, Aerial view of heavily bombed area near the Normandy coast, bomb craters everywhere. 25
- 6, V.S. Troops looking at damaged gun emplacements of the Atlantic Wall. 41  
*for housing giant rocket shells*
- 7, V.S. Massive concrete structure ~~which was captured prior to completion. Not sure for what use this site was to be used.~~ 70
- 8, V.S. Camouflaged shed which was a V1 store ~~for~~ robot rockets. 24
- 9, V.S. Naval barrage being laid by British and American ships off Normandy. Shells burst near the ships and the H.M.S. Glasgow has to make a run for it. 68
- 10, L.S. Mass drop of supplies by parachutes from Stirling bombers. 37
- 11, V.S. R.A.S.C. men go out and get the supplies from the containers. 24
- 12, V.S. U.S. Infantry moving along road towards Cherbourg and in the outskirts the soldiers have to avoid sniper fire. The U.S. soldiers fire back during running street battle. 118
- 13, M.S. German soldier with white flag coming out of large doorway. He leads out a line of prisoners with their arms raised. 43
- 14, V.S. More prisoners being rounded up, This includes shot of American soldier with bandage over his face while guarding the prisoners, he looks very bloody. They then frisk the prisoners and march them off. 102
- 15, M.S. Inside medical tent a U.S. Doctor with a nurse pose with newly born baby and the French mother. 18
- 16, V.S. Showing surrender of high ranking German officers. Lieut. Gen; Carl Wilhelm von Schlieben capitulate to General Collins. Then Rear Admiral Hennecke, Sea Defence Commander is brought in. 80

FALL OF CHERBOURG

1. LS & MS Devastated Railway Marshalling Yard at Cherbourg. - US Troops & French Civilians relaying tracks.etc.
2. LS & MS Devastated village of Valognes - US Troops dynamiting Houses & Walls - CU Detonator Plunger - ( Good shots explosions etc).
3. LS & MS US Troops in Captured Enemy Material Park. (German Captured Tanks, Guns & Cars etc.)
4. Aerial shots Bomb Craters - MS & CU Damaged Concrete Gun emplacements of the Atlantic Wall.
5. LS & MS Massive Concrete Structure under construction by the Germans when captured (?) - LS & MS Camouflaged VI Site.
6. LS & MS US & Br Warships firing Guns at sea - LS HMS Glasgow being shelled - MS Shells bursting in water.
7. LS Planes dropping supplies by parachute - MS Airborne soldiers collecting supplies with jeep & trailer.
8. LS, MS & CU US Infantry advancing in Cherbourg - street fighting etc.
9. MS German Soldier with White Flag coming out of large doorway - MS Line of POWs coming out of doorway.
10. CU US Soldier with bandaged face guarding POWs.
11. MS German POWs being searched by US Soldiers - MS Column of POWs marching. (headed by two women civilian prisoners).
12. US Doctor & Nurse with French Mother & Small baby.
13. MS & CU Lt.Gen. C.W. Von SCHLIEBEN capitulating Gen. COLLINS (US). Rear Admiral HENNECKE with US Officers.
