- 1, V.S. Buildings near Paris that look like flats, the inmates are collaborators awaiting some sort of trial by the liberators. 37
- 2, V.S. General Eisenhower at Tomb of Unknown Warrior in Paris. He lays wreath and says a few words S.O.F. He praises the Parisians and presents a shield. General de Gaulle is just seen in one shot. 40
- 3, V.S. At Lyons the hospital is still held by snipers, allied troops in the streets fire back. People take cover from the sniper fire. They lay flat on the ground. 70
- 4, L.S. The hospital dome catches fire and the sniper fire ceases. 32
- 5, V.S. British armour rolling across Bailey Bridges over the Albert Canal in Belgium. 30
- 6, Ground to air of R.A.F. Stirling dropping supplies by parachute. Men of Belgium's White Army are ready to pick up the arms dropped from the drop to continue their fight. 60
- 7, E.S. General Montgomery arriving in open car in Brussels, crowds cheer him. 12
- 8, L.S. Montgomery salutes from Town Hall balcony. 15
- 9, V.S. British Army vehicles moving through Antwerp, first through burning buildings and then through cheering crowds. 40
