LAST ROUND AND LAST LAP.

(Fight)

Round 15 of the great fight for the British Heavyweight Championship between Freddie Mills and bald-headed Jack London, at Belle Vue Manchester. The fight has gone the full length and everything hangs on these last few minutes. At the ring-side are well-known sporting broadcasters Raymond Glendenning and W. Barrington Dalby. The 6,000 spectators see victory turned to defeat as Freddy, who has been notching up points for most of the fight, gets a terrific slogging with Jack's full 15 stone behind it.

Jack drives Freddy on to the ropes, and swings over fierce punches. Both men are trying hard to force a decision.

The gong brings the round- and the fight- to an end. The referee adds up the points ...and the verdict goes to Jack London. But Freddy's attitude has been one of great sportsmanship throughout and he's a good loser. Out of breath but happy, Jack London poses with his wife and two boys for this first picture of a new champion.

St.Leger. Panters on the look out for a fortune gather at Newmarket for what may well be the last war-time St.Leger. The field of seventeen gets away to a good start and settles down to a closely-contested race.

A well-bunched field is led for the first mile by the 10-1 'dark horse' "ORESTES", with "Model", "Growing Confidence" and "Glide Away" not far behind.

Three furlongs from home the second favourite TEHRAN, takes the lead. Strong challenges by BOREALIS on the outside and OCEAN SWELL on the rails are held off, and TEHRAN passes the winning post with a length-and-a-half lead.

Leading in the winner, TEHRAN's great race brings both his owner, the AGA KHAN and his jockey, Gordon Richards, their fifth St.Leger victory.
