

ENGLAND STRIKES OIL.

Drilling began after British experts had made exhaustive tests in many parts of the country. Now over 200 oil-wells are in full production. Great storage tanks have been erected; special railwags have been built; and each year over 26 million gallons of crude oil pour into tank wagons for transit to the refineries.
