Within a few days of the attack on the Kamba Dam on the Bhine, R.A.F. Basher Command sent its Lancasters in an assault on the heavy gan positions on the Dutch island of Welcharen.

This attack is an integral part of the close air support which is being given to the Ganadian Army in this seeker, engaged in some of the toughest fighting since "D"-Day. Lancasters also bombed and burnt the dyke near Veere to let the sea in on the Germans.
