Four-engined bombers of the R.A.F. make a heavy and concentrated attack on the German town of Brunswick. Over eight-hundred tons of incendiaries and our best and biggest bombs set this great aircraft and industrial centre blazing and wreck havoc on the intricate network of railways.

As the fires spread and the whole city becomes ablaze, the thought of what it must be like down there is terrifying.....yet Bomber Command consider this only a secondary raid and not a major attack.....During this attack on Brunswick, a far greater force of bombers is over Duisberg, which received over 10,000 tons of bombs in two great raids.
