BISHOP OF ST. ALBAN'S  
ENTHRONED.

The Cathedral and Abbey Church of St. Alban stands on one of the most historic spots in England for it was on this site that Alban, Britain's first Martyr, gave his life early in the fourth century. For the first time in the Abbey's history, Pathe Gazette is privileged to take these exclusive pictures - the enthronement of the Rt. Rev. Philip Henry Lloyd, formerly Bishop of Nasik, Deccan, India. After entering the West door, the Bishop takes the oath of fidelity before the Altar in the Nave.

The only part of the service held in the Choir was the actual enthronement by the Archdeacon of Canterbury.

The Bishop, at the Nave Altar, blesses the people. The solemn and picturesque ceremonies conclude with the Dean and other dignitaries pledging obedience to the Bishop and kissing his ring.
