housing is being tackled in Tottenham, North-East London - American
pre-fabricated homes, provided under lease-lend, are built in colonies
on bombed-out areas. On to foundations of 4 inch thick congrete,
crates containing the sections of a four-roomed dwelling, are slung,

The whole house can be erected rapidly by manual labour. The temporary pretetype houses are the first of 30,000 to be put up in this country. They fit them together as easily as children's building blocks.

Here in Woelwich permanent pre-fabricated houses costing between eight and nine hundred pounds each are being erected in the present-day manner of building. In ten weeks semething like a little suburb will have been fitted and slotted into place.

A nevel sight is the alinging into position of a complete kitchen. Everything and the Kitchen stove - in one unit dropped into place and ready for use.
