

DIEPPE ANNIVERSARY

The third Anniversary of the Dieppe Raid, and the beaches where many a gallant soldier died. In the city's cemetery, more than 800 graves, most of them Canadian, were tended by French civilians throughout the German occupation. At the Anniversary ceremonies a plaque was unveiled which reads "From Dieppe's War Prisoners to the Heroes of the Second Canadian Division." Afterwards, Canadian, British, American and French troops took part in a ceremonial march past.
