KING PETER

A tragic dynasty meets a new disaster. King Peter of Yugoslavia - seen here at his wedding in 1944 - has been deprived of his throne by a proclamation of Marshal Tito. Last month the 22 year old King attended the christening of his heir, Prince Alexander, born to be a King and now one more of Europe - Ex-Princes. But tragedy has followed the Karageorgevich dynasty since Peter's father was murdered in 1934 at Marseilles. Peter, then a boy King of eleven, returned home from his school in England to take a troubled throne. Refusing to surrender his claims, he goes into exile.
