THE PASSING OF LOND LANG

The funeral service for Lord Lang of Lembeth, Archbishep of Canterbury and Primate of All England, was conducted at Westminster Abbey according to ancient ecclesiastical tradition. From the West Door, the coffin leaves for its last journey to Canterbury.
