### VARSIITY SPORTS

The seventy-second inter-varsity sports at London's White City gave Cambridge a 65 to 43 point victory in an afternoon of close finishes. The 220 yards low hurdles went to Oxford's Day and MacSwiney. It was the Dark Blues again in the long jump.

A winning jump of 21ft 8½ inches gave first place to Oxford's J. Merrish. Feature of the meeting was a pistol packing, Buffalo Bill type starter. Star race of the day was the 880 yards. Faster half-miles have been run on this track, but few have been more thrilling. Mark, the Cambridge secretary, (number 5) leads all the way.

Lapping a quarter mile in 58 seconds Mark looks a certain winner. But watch this for a dramatic finish. 100 yards from home Gibson of Oxford (number 4) battles his way into the picture. A toe to toe fight for first place, and a lung-bursting last sprint, gives Gibson the race.
