GRAND PRIX AT NICE

Car racing rears back into the headlines as the famous Nice Grand Prix brings eleven high powered speedsters back on the roads. Cars in the 15 to 25 c.c class bump up the surface of the Promenade des Anglais. A course of 130 miles, it packs 65 turns and brings Europe's ace wheelmen back to the old thrills of the race. Out in front were Villorosi in an Alfa Romeo and Semmer in a Maserati - famous names that helped to make the Nice Grand Prix one of racing's biggest draws.

Semmer notched the best speed on the turns with 70 miles an hour and came second. Winning average was Villorosi's 65 miles an hour - good going round those 65 bends.
