PARIS VICTORY PARADE

A short head in front of London, Paris puts on her Victory Parade. Hub of all the coromonial is the Aru de Triamphe as columns of mon and armour deploy down the famous Avenue de la Grande Armee and Champs Elysee. British, French and American troops figure provincetly among the massed columns, pictured by Pathe nowman stationed on top of the Are.

In Paris for the Mig Four meeting Mr. Bevin had a ringside seat as infantymen step out in the march past.

American military-police - known over here as Eisenhower's snowdrops - go through a tricky ploce of maneeuvring.

Contingents of many French calculal regiments brought pageantry and colour. Reminiscent of Frence's great peace-time parades, their magnificent military bearing has survived the camouflage-drabmens of medern war.

Britain's Royal Welsh Fusiliers brought along their goat mascet to add another success to his many campaigns. Another hardened veteran was a ram - so well trained that he leads his plateen without a guide.
