

THE PRINCESS A WELSH BARD

In a beautiful Welsh glade at Mountain Ash, the Gorsedd Circle had been erected for the National Histeddied of Wales. To the ancient ceremonial and the age-long traditions of the Bards is added a new note. Princess Elizabeth becomes an honorary Bard.
