26 DIE IN AIR CRASH

The dense forests of Newfoundland. Here wait eighteen survivors of one of flying's most tragic accidents. Below, the broken shell of a Skymaster air-liner. Near the end of its flight from Belgium, the aircraft crashed in fog and rain in a vain effort to make Newfoundland's Gander Airfield. Helicopters rescue the eighteen survivors, two of them gravely injured.

After a hundred hours of pain and exposure (their wounds dressed by a first aid party) they reach hospital at Gander. They are safe now - but back there with the crashed plane, 26 passengers died.
