Near the end of its flight from Belgium, the aircraft crashed in fog and rain in a wain effort to make Newfoundland's Sander Airfield. Helicopters rescue the eighteen survivers, two of them gravely injured.

After a hundred hours of pain and exposure (their wounds dressed by a first aid party) they reach hospital at Gander. They are safe now - but back there with the crashed plane, 26 passengers died,
