From Meerut first pictures of the Indian National Congress. Pundit Nehra addresses the assembled delegates. Under his leadership they have preclaimed their new Indian Republic. At these meetings (and later at the meeting of the Indian Constituent Assembly in New Delhi) Pundit Nehru declared his party's policy. He refused to wait for an agreement with his Moslem League opponents. Britain, he said, must quit India. Nemtime India's Princes and the Country's \$0,000,000 Moslems refuse to accept the rule of the Congress Party. If Britain leaves, bloodshed may discolour the flag of the new India.
