

SOCCER STARS WERE ON FORM

At Goodison Park. Liverpool, England's League Stars shine in the match against the Irish League. Final score - 4-2 - and an England win. Our sports cameras spotlight the fast moving English forward line. Watch Jimmy Hagan No. 10 of Sheffield United, back in representative football. He played a brilliant game. Sharp shooting makes him a good bet for the inside-left position in the all-Britain team playing Europe. Behind Hagan, Blackpool's Johnston No. 6, gave his forwards all the passes. Jimmy Hagan is off again and Irish goalie Kelly almost fumbles the clearance.

Now for the twinkling feet of wizard of dribble - No. 7 - Stoke's Stanley Matthews. Stan was back to his old form and showed that he has lost no pace. Our verdict: he is still Britain's fastest right winger. Stan passes to Wilf Mannion who shoots just outside the goal. New discovery is Burnley amateur, Peter Kippax, No. 11. Ex-fighter pilot, he is the first amateur for 19 years to get into a football league side.
