ENGLAND WINS OVER SCOTLAND - RUGBY

At Twickenham, England (in white) meets Scotland in the Calcutta Cup match. What's more they confounded the critics, with a 24 points to 5 win. And here is England's try number 1. Skipper Jack Heaton converts with a fine kick.

The Scottish team was cooped up for nearly 20 hours on a snow-bound train. Their play suffered and England were a much superior side. Here England scores another try. In brilliant form Heaton again converts to put England 14 points ahead.

Now, still another for England with Heaton finishing off the job.

Outstanding in the English team were the half-backs. They were good opportunists and quick on the ball. Want of "match-practice" made the players brittle, and there were many injuries. Scotland's only try was scored by London-Scottish Jackson.

Converting Scotland's try is Geddes.

The game's closing stages were marked by a mixture of stoppages, good play and wild rushes, all against a background of heavy snow. Yet England score again. Heaton converts try No. 5 to give England a big margin victory.

It was surprising win for the England team which took all chances. They were worthy winners. The 70,000 crowd stuck it right through the snowstorm to see the 68th year of Calcutta Cup matches end with another England triumph.
