MOUNTBATTEN TAKES OVER

At Delhi - Lord Louis Mountbatten arrives to take up his appointment as India's Vicercy and Governor-General. At a crucial moment in India's history, the 47 year old grandson of Queen Victoria scomes the 29th and last Vicercy. First to hold the office was Visecunt Canning in 1858, the 21st year of Queen Fictoria's reign.
