The eye place of a damped civilian gas mask is believed to have caused the fire. It acted as a burning glass. From it, the Covernment depot of 10,000 tens of rebber became an almost total less. Fisnes leept from one tyre pile to mother, making the whole depot a circle of fisms.

Firmen fought all afternoon and evening to control the blane. Only a narrow street separated dealling houses from the damp. Their ecoupants helped the firmen in their task. Damage is estimated at £40,000. It was a fire som by 10 million Londoners.
