

PEOPLE IN CAMERA

At Fratton Park, Portsmouth Football ground, Al Phillips of Aldgate tunes up for his fight with coloured challenger, Cliff Anderson. Britain's youngest boxing promoter, 27 year old Benny Smith is staging the bout at London's Olympia. Phillips' Empire Featherweight title is at stake.

Perhaps Phillips wants a foreraste of his July date. His sparring partner could be Anderson's double. In March, Phillips gained a points verdict over the boxer from British Guiana. This was the most disputed boxing decision since Joe Louis beat Tommy Farr. At Olympia, it may be different.

To Northolt from Paris comes Foreign Secretary Bevin. Waiting to meet him were Pathe News, the B.B.C. and representatives of the world's newspapers. On the airfield the reporters pressed him hard.
