Later the King presented cups to the show winners. More than ever, Britain turns to her farmers to provide the feed we need so badly.

The Enights of St. John return to Scotland. At Edinburgh's Holyroodhouse, members of Britain's oldest order of chivalry most for its reconstitution in Scotland after an absence of nearly 400 years. The Grand Prior of the Order (The Duke of Gloucester) walks in procession with the Earl of Lindsay to the Palace.

From Holymocheuse, the procession moves off to the preseptory. Here the Grand Prior and the Scottish order take over the priory. Founded soon after the 1st Granade, the Enights of St. John were banned in Scotland by Mary Queen of Scots.

In the uniform of a Colonel of the Gordan Highlanders, the Duke bids farewell to the Rhights of the Scottish order.
