Wembley Dog Show

Mothers' Pilgrimage

To Walsingham, Norfolk, go two thousand Roman Catholic mothers from all parts of the United Kingdom. In the Middle Ages, millions of pilgrims visited the shrine at the Augustinian Priory. Today, the Priory is in ruins - only the East Front of the Church still stands. It is in these historic surroundings that Cardinal Griffin, Archbishop of Westminster, and the Roman Catholic Bishop of Northampton hold the service.

The ruins of the Priory stand in the grounds of a Norfolk country house. In recent years, new pilgrims have come to Walsingham. The Church of England the Roman Catholic Church have each built a shrine here.
