St. Nazaire

Here, British Victoria Cross and French Croix de Guerre hang side by side.

The Commandos - civilians again - march past the citizens of St. Nazaire to the spot where a memorial to the action is unveiled by the Premier. Only 270 of the 600 who fought at St. Nazaire survive today. But their epitaph endures on France's monument.
