White-banded Sayajirae is among the bunch - close to the rails. Arbar moves up on the outside, as they turn the band and head out on the last straight home.

With "Migali" and "Pearl Diver" falling back, it's now a fight between Arbar and Sayajirao. Jockey Britt on "Sayajirao" is in the lead, still fighting it out with the French horse. Emought at a yearling for 28,000 gaineas by the Gaskmar of Bareda, Sayajirao, brother of Barby winner Dante, wins the St. Legar, still followed by Arbar. Odds of 9 to 2 came off. As the great crowds jostle their way from the course back to workshops and fasteries, memories of seven years age crowd in. The spirit of daring and courage that brought vistory to the few in 1940 must stir the nation again if the new battle is to be wen.
