These pictures show the life cycle of a flower. The camera makes its growth visible to the human eye. An American Banker John Ott has perfected this device. In the cellar of his Illinois home he has set up power lamps and miniature cameras. This is the twisting movement of an unfolding Iris. Ott's method is to make a series of single pictures over several weeks, if these pictures are projected one after the like a film script the growth of a flower can be watched, accelerated a thousand times. The camera gives valuable service to mans study of nature.
