Right up till three years ago, prospecting went on around the <u>chores</u> of Steep Rock Lake, before it was decided that the main ore body lay <u>under</u> the water.

Hundreds of manhours were spent preparing the damming of the lake's arm. Surveyors brought up special pumps to suck up 125 billion gallons of water. 3 million cubic yards of rock and earth were drilled to divert the river into a new course.

Today, ore exports reach an all-time high and Ganada's red mud sails out to most the world's steel target.
