In Osaka - Japan's main spapert and chief industrial city Kerean rioters start the first of many street battles which have
led the American authorities to declare a state of limited
emergency. As speakers protest against the teaching of Japanese
in Kerean schools, the mob gets out of hand.

Fereibly cooled down, the young rioters still continue to domenstrate. More than a thousand are arrested. The disturbances, (alleged to be Communist inspired) are the first signs of unrest in Japan - seriously hindering MacArthur's programme of recenstruction.

KOREAN RIOTS

Koreans payade in Japan's semport city of Ocaka at the start of one of many riots which have led to the first state of "limited emergency" since the American compation. Speakers protest the teaching of the Japanese language in Korean schools, the meb gets out of hand - and the police move in.

Casualties are carried off by both sides while hoses dreak up the demonstration. American treops have assisted in quelling outbreaks believed to be Communist-Inspired in an effort to embarrase the U.S. in the Kerean elections. Over a thousand are agreeted as the Red pattern of chaos takes its tell in Japan.
