KOREA RIOTS - 1000 ARRESTED

In Osaka - Japan's main seaport and chief industrial city - Korean rioters start the first of many street battles which have led the American authorities to declare a state of limited emergency. As speakers protest against the teaching of Japanese in Korean schools, the mob gets out of hand.

Forcefully cooled down, the young rioters still continue to demonstrate. More than a thousand are arrested. The disturbances, (alleged to be Communist inspired) are the first signs of unrest in Japan - seriously hindering MacArthur's programs of reconstruction.

American troops have assisted in quelling outbreaks believed to be Communist-inspired in an effort to embarrass the U.S. in the Korean elections. Over a thousand are arrested as the Red pattern of chaos takes its toll in Japan.
