In London's Guildhall, the Freedom of the City is conferred upon Philip, Duke of Edinburgh. The coronary is witnessed by his wife, awarded the same honour a year ago.

After the Duke has taken the Cath, Lord Mayor Bracowill Cath, hands him an eak box, containing his scroll of Freedom.

In his first official speech made before such a gathering, Philip mentions the City's benowing of great allied War leaders and continues:
