BULGARIA TURNS FOSTER PARENTS

Disembarking in Sofia, another trainload of abducted Greek children is destined for an upbringing on the Eastern European plan. They join seventeen hundred others already in Bulgaria. Over twelve thousand are held in countries beyond the Greek border.

Bulgaria's medical services take them in hand. The physical condition of each child is carefully noted. Totalitarian hygiene is very thorough.

Humanitarian reasons are advanced as justification for the abduction of these children from their parents. Stubbornly unconverted to this new doctrine of kindness a Greek grandmother looks on with bitter eye.

Greece, backed by United Nations, appeals without success, for the repatriation of the children, victims of a callous ideology which scorns all family ties.
