In Lourdes - the little French town which 90 years ago this month became the scene of a miracle - world pilgrims express their faith in christianity.

From America, the archbishop of Boston leads a party of the faithful. They are joined by others from Britain, from Helland and from Belgium. From other parts of Europe, (where religion today calls for courage as well as faith) come others who risk their homes to pray at the shrine of Bernadette.

The forces of religion grow steadily. Massing against the grey beliefs of the new idealogies are the simple faiths which alearly distinguish good from evil.
