PAKISTAN MOURNS JINNAH

Pakistan - the Commonwealth's youngest dominion - mourns the passing of her leader and first Governor General - Mahomed Ali Jinnah. His followers bring fresh earth from all parts of the country to the grave where their beloved Quaid-i-Azam is being buried in Karachi - the capital which he entered in triumph only a year ago.

Mr. Jinnah's devoted sister - Fatima - is the chief mourner. Ranking with Gandhi and Nehru in the influence he wielded, he saw his life's work fulfilled with the birth of Pakistan.
