PAKISTAN MOURNS JINNAH.

Roll 1.

Mr. Jinnah's coffin is seen being buried (distant view). Crowds round the burial pier. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ There was a lot of excitement among ~~XXXXXX~~ the crowd to have a last view of the coffin.

Roll 2.

Shots of filling the grave with mud. The mud is scattered away properly. The religious head Maulana Usmani offers prayer at the grave. Next day the grave was covered with flowers. Thousands of followers of Mr. Jinnah come and offer flowers at the grave. Priests are seen reciting the holy Quran in their traditional style. More shots of the flower offerings. Shots of the tent pitched over the grave.

Roll 3.

A few more shots of the grave and the gathering round it. Flags of India, Afganistan, U.S.A. and U.K. are seen at half mast over their respective diplomatic offices. Shots of mourners parading on the streets of Karachi. Shots of Quran Recitation at the Government House.

Roll 4.

Long shots of Moslems reciting Quran in the Government House compound. Medium shots. Close-ups. Close-up of a minister and Sir Mohammed Zafar ulish Khan reciting Quran. Shots of Mr. Zikar Ali Khan the Pakistan Prime Minister reading Quran (profile). Shots of Miss Fatima Jinnah the late Mr. Jinnah's sister. She is the chief mourner.
