U.N.O. INDICTS INDIA

In Paris, United Nations holds its third General Assembly. Under the symbol of peace through power of reason, Sir Alexander Cadogan as President opens the meeting.

Meantime, the Dominion of India acquires another warship and her Prime Minister, Pandit Nehru, welcomes this addition to the Indian Navy. United Nations interest centred on Pandit Nehru when his government took military action against Hyderabad as that state laid its case before United Nations...for peaceful settlement. In Bareda, India has proved that peaceful methods bring results, for its Maharajah, at Nehru's intervention, hands the reins of government to the people of the State. But in Hyderabad, India risks firing racial war by provoking armed resistance by the Muslims, whose deep feelings are voiced in defeat by Karim Rasvi, leader of the Rasakars.

India now promises Hyderabad freedom but the world regards her aggressive methods as a threat to Peace.
